Case Study







Following an initial enquiry from the local council, Coverad were invited to Woodside Academy to use their expertise in radiator cover installation to advise them of the potential offerings that were available to them.

The School wanted to keep the existing wet system, however, as the school was to be refurbished, the radiators, although providing sufficient heat, were suffering from years of wear and tear.

They also had the added complication of having to apply with safe surface temperature guidelines.

As usual, the current radiators were installed in awkward places and, as there was not much space (and budget available) to move the radiators, the standard offerings of off the shelf LST Radiators were not an option.

As they adhere to the Safe Surface Low Temperature Guidelines, bespoke size and manufactured Standard Steel LST Covers were recommended. Protecting both the radiators and pupil's welfare.

After learning that Coverad manufacture their own radiator covers in house, Woodside Academy decided to make use of Coverad's powder coating plant to match the radiator covers with the colour scheme of the school.

The colour was matched and the Standard Steel Radiator Covers were finished in a blue powder coat.

This has transformed a tired radiator into a modern, bright and safe LST Cover which compliments the newly refurbished corridor.
